

Dear Parent/Caregiver,

As part of NAIDOC Celebrations (continuing on from 2021), the Wagga NAIDOC Committee are hosting a Youth Cultural Camp for students aged 12-16yrs. This camp is for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander children only.

DATE: Friday 14th January to Sunday 16th January 2022. VENUE: Borambola Sport and Recreation Centre, 1980 Sturt Highway, Wagga Wagga COST: FREE

The 2 night camp will provide an opportunity for children to connect with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander culture, unplug and unwind in a fun and exciting setting. Along with the cultural content there will be a range of leisure activities provided by the centre including swimming, archery, rock climbing etc.

In light of the recent spike in COVID numbers in our region, all children MUST have their COVID-19 vaccination and up to date medical information must be provided on the attached form. This will be enforced to help protect our community and to reduce risk of transmission due to being in close proximity for an extended period of time.

WHAT TO BRING:

Children will need to bring swimmers, towel, hat, pillow and appropriate clothing. Sleeping bags will be provided.

IMPORTANT:

- 1. Children and parents must read the below behaviour policy and sign the attached consent form
- 2. If a child misbehaves, parents/guardians will be requested to collect them from camp immediately. Parents/guardians must be reachable at all times.
- 3. Mobile phones will be allowed for free time only. During all activities phones will be collected and placed in a safe place, this is so all students are active participants in the camp program.
- 4. All staff and supervisors are appropriately qualified and hold a Working with Children's Check.
- 5. This is not a school excursion however children will be required to follow rules, behave appropriately and follow all guidelines to ensure the safety and enjoyment of all children and staff in attendance.
